

Due Diligence Policy

Introduction:

Allcost Têxteis para Hotelaria, Lda. undertakes to develop its activity in an ethical, responsible and sustainable manner, ensuring high standards of legal, environmental, social and governance compliance throughout its value chain.

As a company in the textile sector, we recognize the specific risks associated with the industry, namely regarding the use of chemical substances, environmental impact of production processes, subcontracting and working conditions.

This Due Diligence Policy establishes the minimum requirements applicable to all Allcost suppliers and business partners.

Scope:

This policy applies to:

- Suppliers;
- Subcontractors;
- Logistics and commercial partners;

Principles and Requirements:

Suppliers must comply with all applicable legislation, namely in:

- Labour
- Environmental
- Tax
- Health and Safety at Work
- Chemical regulation (including REACH, when applicable)

Subcontracting:

Unauthorized subcontracting is not permitted.

Any subcontracting must be previously communicated and approved by Allcost, with the supplier being responsible for ensuring that its subcontractors comply with the requirements established in this policy.

Traceability:

Whenever applicable, traceability must be ensured:

- Of raw material origin
- Of production processes
- Of the country of production
